### **The Shirley Aitken Participation Awards**

This award focuses on student participation. One award will be given out each year. It is awarded to the student who exhibits the most pieces of work within his/her grade level. The student will receive a small plaque recognizing their hard work and contribution to the Education department. The students name will also be displayed on a perpetual plaque that will remain in the exhibit hall.

### **KINDERGARTEN (Year 1/Year 2):**

1. **Paper Plate Animal** - Create an animal using a paper plate.
2. **Printing** - Print the sentence "I can \_\_\_\_\_." and draw a picture of something you can do. (8.5 x11" paper)
3. **Beautiful Butterflies** - create a butterfly using any medium
4. **Favourite Season** - What's your favourite season? Draw a picture and write about it.
5. **Mix it!** Mix some paint and create some beautiful flowers.
6. **Build a Bug!** Use materials of any type to create a bug. Be creative!
7. **Any creative design** using a variety of recycled items.  
(Maximum height not to exceed 15 inches.)

### **Grade 1, 2, 3:**

1. **Poster** - Create a Poster advertising our fair's 2023 theme "Country Nights & Carnival Lights". Be creative!
2. **Pointillism** - create a picture using this technique. (paper size not to exceed 11x17)
3. **Planet Facts** - Choose a planet, illustrate it and write a fun fact about it.
4. **Math Activity** - Any work demonstrating a particular math related concept - (please indicate concept on exhibit tag).
5. **Super Symmetry** - Complete the photograph. Cut a magazine photo in half. Draw the other half of the picture. Your drawing must match the picture as much as possible. Colour using pencil crayons.
6. **Every Day is Earth Day** - What is one way that you can help the Earth? Illustrate and write about it.
7. **French Activity** - Create a poster (Poster must contain the French Language)
8. **Invent Something!** Build a 3D model using recycled materials of your choice and include a written explanation.
9. **French Activity** - Illustrate a scene of your choice and label it
10. **Any creative design using a variety of recycled items.**  
(Maximum height not to exceed 15 inches.)

### **Grade 4, 5, 6:**

1. **Best Handwriting** - List 10 Canadian Tourist Attractions
2. **Create a Poster/Advertisement** of something you want to sell (eg. Energy drink)
3. **Poster** - Create a Poster advertising our fair's 2023 theme "Country Nights & Carnival Lights". Be creative!
3. **Super Symmetry** - Complete the photograph. Cut a magazine photo in half. Draw the other half of the picture. Your drawing must match the picture as much as possible. Colour using pencil crayons.
