The Shirley Aitken Participation Awards

This award focuses on student participation. One award will be given out each year. It is awarded to the student who exhibits the most pieces of work within his/her grade level. The student will receive a small plaque recognizing their hard work and contribution to the Education department. The students name will also be displayed on a perpetual plaque that will remain in the exhibit hall.

KINDERGARTEN (Year 1/Year 2):

1. **Printing** - Print the sentence "I like to _____." and draw a picture of you and what you can do. (8.5 x11" paper)
2. **Create an insect** - be creative!
3. **Plenty of Patterns** - Create and extend a pattern using materials of your choice.
4. **Creations by Colour Mixing** (Paper size not to exceed 60x90cm)
5. **Fun with rainbows** - any rainbow creation using any medium.
6. **Painting** - any painted picture.

7. **Fun with Feathers** - a creative piece created using feathers!
8. **Any creative design using a variety of recycled items.**
(Maximum height not to exceed 40 cm.)
9. **Open class** - any flat or 3-D item that will stand on a shelf.

Grade 1, 2, 3:

1. **Pointillism** - create a picture using this technique. (paper size not to exceed 11x17)
2. **Friendly Letter** - Write a letter to someone special - include all the important parts (heading, greeting, body, closing, signature)
3. **Math Activity** - Any work demonstrating a particular math related concept - (please indicate concept on exhibit tag).
4. **Super Symmetry** - Complete the photograph. Cut a magazine photo in half. Draw the other half of the picture. Your drawing must match the picture as much as possible. Colour using pencil crayons.
5. **Pretty Pastels** - any child drawn picture using pastels on flat paper (any size).
6. **French Activity** - Create a poster (Poster must contain the French Language)
7. **Project** - any **Science/Health/Social Studies project**: may include poster, diorama, or model small enough to sit on a shelf.
8. **French Activity** - Illustrate a scene of your choice and label it
- Anything Goes** - work that does not fit in any other category

Grade 4, 5, 6:

1. **** Write a Paragraph on what the fair means to you.** The top 10 winners will be invited to be "guest managers" in the ring at the Wrestling Show taking place at the 2016 Stormont County Fair. ****** On the students exhibit tag (with parent permission), please indicate the student's phone number for contacting purposes in July.
2. **Best Handwriting** - List your 10 favourite places to visit.
3. **Create a comic strip** (must have at least 3 panels)
4. **Super Symmetry** - Complete the photograph. Cut a magazine photo in half. Draw the other half of the picture. Your drawing must match the picture as much as possible. Colour using pencil crayons.
5. **Math Activity** - Any work demonstrating a particular math related concept - **(please indicate concept on exhibit tag).**
6. **Poetry** - any creative writing piece composed by the student **ex. limericks, verses, haiku etc....**
7. **French Activity** - Create a Poster of your choice (Poster must contain French Language)
8. **Project** - any **Science/Health/Social Studies project:** may include poster, diorama, or model small enough to sit on a shelf.
9. **Sculpting** -Create an object using modeling clay
10. **Anything Goes** - work that does not fit in any other category
