Registration Fee: \$20.00, driver gets a Sponsor Pass **Rules and Regulations** (based on Min. of 70 cars/trucks)

- 1- All Vehicles must be 1980 and up.
- 2- NO ENGINE SWAPS, must be factory (stock).
- 3- All drivers must wear approved helmets and safety glasses or goggles. Seat belts must be worn.
- 4- Anyone under the influence of **ALCOHOL or DRUGS** will not be permitted to drive. No obscene or vulgar writing on vehicle.
- 5- Intentional hit on opponent's driver's side door will result in **DISQUALIFICATION**.
- 6- Entrants must be 18 years or older. Parent's signature on registration form for 16 & 17 year olds. No driver substitution on registered vehicles.
- 7- A siren and red flashing lights will indicate START, FINISH, and EMERGENCY. All vehicles must stop and/or leave ring as directed of the official.
- 8- There is a 60 second rule in place. Driver must start stalled vehicles and proceed to make a hit within this time frame or be disqualified.
- 9- All vehicles must be inspected for safety prior to start of the derby. Absolutely NO reinforcements.
- 10- If a vehicle is disqualified for any reason, NO REFUND.
- 11- Remove all glass, plastic, light bulbs. Vehicle must be clean of loose objects and glass. All trailer hitches must be removed. Airbags must be removed or disabled.
- 12- Vehicles with electric fuel pumps must have a safety shut off switch, painted red on dash.
- 13- Cooling system- water only; NO ANTIFREEZE
- 14- No wheel weights on rims.
- 15- Tires must be D.O.T. approved.
- 16- Gas tank must be relocated to the back seat area of the vehicle and be securely fastened. Gas tank must be covered after inspection.
- 17- Battery should be located on the floor on the front passenger side of the vehicle.

- 18- Pillar to pillar bar must be on 45 degree angle. Driver's door bar permitted, 2 inches wide with no sharp ends and 6 inches past door seams.
- 19- An 8 inch hole must be cut in the hood.
- 20- Once a heat is over, all vehicles will be placed in a secure area that is only accessible by Derby Committee. NO drivers will have access until derby is over.
- 21- All parts and vehicles must be removed from fairgrounds by 7:00am Saturday.
- 22- Any Stoppage in the event due to fire or vehicle on cement barrier will result in that vehicle being finished for the night.
- 23- **There are to be no alcoholic beverages on fairground property unless in a licenced area. THE DEMOLITION COMMITTEE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO DISQUALIFY ANY CAR IF DRIVER/Pit Crew are SUSPECTED OR CONFIRMED TO BE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF DRUGS OR ALCOHOL.**

Truck Specific Rules

- 1- Must be Stock. Any half ton truck permitted, 1980 or newer. No 4 x 4's.
- 2- Will allow engine and transmission swap from one make to another.
- 3- Frame and differential must remain stock. NO reinforcements.
- 4- Bumper can be welded to mounting brackets and welded to frame. Bumpers must be stock with no modifications or reinforcements.
- 5- Eight additional body mounts will be permitted. 3/8 inch threaded rod, 4 in cab, 4 in box.
- 6- All body panels must remain in factory positions.
- 7- Roll cage will be permitted, welded to frame inside four corners of cab area
- 8- Driver's door bar permitted on outside of door, 2 inches wide, and can extend past door seams 6 inches with no sharp ends and flush to body.
- 9- Suspension must remain stock, No lift kits
- 10- Tire must be DOT approved.
- 11- Gas tank secured to front of box.

STOCK V8 Any engine combination/swap from one make to the other is allowed.
