

## Mini Classes

### Cart Classes: (Men's, Ladies, Golden Age)

**Gaits:** Halt, Walk, and Trot (both working and strong trots)  
Botibi Ways around the ring  
Reverse Across diagonal at direction of announcer or ring official  
Rein back ^Bg^evenly in a straight line and then forward to former position  
Stand quiet in halt, and in the line up

**Judged:** Primarily on suitability of the horse to provide a pleasant drive  
70% performance, manners, & way of going of horse  
20% condition & fit of harness & vehicle  
10% neatness of attire

### Cart Class (Junior)

**Gaits:** Same as above except only one trot (working)

**Judged:** 75% handling of reins, control, posture, & overall appearance  
25% performance & way of going of horse & neatness of attire

### Roadster Cart Class:

**Gait:** Entire ring at a slow Jog trot, then road gait  
Turn counter clockwise at the slow jog trot, then road trot  
Then, at speed (**Drive on**)  
No rein back  
Stand quiet in line up  
To be shown on rail at all times (no reverse across diagonal)

**Judged:** 60% speed & form  
20% conformation & quality  
20% manners and way of going  
All gaits to be considered equally

### Pair/Team Class:

**Gaits:** Same as Adult Cart Classes

**Judged:** Same as Adult Cart Classes

### Tandem:

**Gait:** Walk, Trot both working and strong  
Both ways around the ring  
Reverse across the diagonal at direction of announcer or ring official  
Rein back  
Stand quiet in line up

**Judged:** Performance, manners, quality, overall impression, and matching of team

### Unicorn:

**Gaits:** Walk, Trot  
Both Ways around the ring  
Reverse across diagonal at direction of announcer or ring official  
Rein back  
Stand quiet in line-up

**Judged:** Performance, Presence, quality, manners, & matching in that order

### Four & Six Team:

**Gaits:** Same as Unicorn

**Judged:** Same as Unicorn
