Entry fees (HST included)

Senior: Barrels → \$10.00; Other events → \$8.00

Junior : Barrels → \$8.00; Other events → \$6.00

Peewee: Barrels → \$2.00

All senior and youth events are 1D, peewee will receive gifts

Rules and Regulations:

-All competitors must pay gate fee, no membership fee required. **Riders must have admission bracelet to ride!**

-Every Rider can show a maximum of 3 horses per event. Must have proof of liability insurance (OEF, or other)

-Seniors cannot enter youth events, vice versa. Exception for relay

-Senior is 18 years of age as of January first, peewee is 8 years of age and under as of January 1st.

-Riders must enter at a walk; as soon as you have passed the first post in the chute you may start your run.

-No interference or complaints will be tolerated towards the assistance, office staff, or judge. You will be asked to leave!

-Prize money will be given the day of the show, please wait until we start calling you to come get your money.

-Loss of hat during the run add 5 seconds

-No time for knocked barrel or poles
 -Once your name is called you have 60 seconds to be in the ring
 -Order of go will be posted outside the gate along the fence
 -18 and under must wear a helmet at all times when mounted on the horse
 -Proper western attire is a must.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ALL HORSE CLASSES

1. All heavy horses must show a negative reaction to Coggins Test within the last six (6) months.
2. Any single horse or team of horses may only show in one classification; such as Heavy Draft, etc.
3. Heavy Draft horses to be 1,600 lbs. or over. Light Draft horses to be less than 1,600 lbs.
4. ☆☆ new or updated classes; see website for Miniature Judging standards
5. Commercial or General Purpose to be less than 1,400 lbs. and conforming to the type of a delivery horse.
6. No Exhibitor may draw more than two prize monies in any one Class.
7. All horses must be entered at the Secretary's Office or designated contact before showing commences.
8. All entries must be the property of the Exhibitor OR for a rider, the owner must be entered on the entry form and provide insurance information.
9. See Section for specific entry / late fees and deadlines. Review SAS Rules and Regulations for General Info.
10. All horses to enter Fairgrounds by East Gate.



11. No verbal or telephone entries. The completed Entry form must be submitted.
12. All late entries, in every Class, to be charged late entry fee. Heavy Horse gate admission will not be refunded on late entries.
13. All Exhibitors are required to have their own liability insurance and show proof of same before exhibiting.
14. Heavy Horse exhibitors will be issued an Admittance Pass upon receipt of entry form. One (1) pass for every two (2) animals.
