

JUDGES AND THEIR DUTIES

The Judges appointed in the Home Craft Division are requested to meet and report themselves at the Secretary's office not later than 10:30 am on Friday of Stormont County Fair and will then be furnished with Badges, Class Books and Prize Tickets so as to enable them to proceed with the judging of their respective classes immediately.

The Judges appointed in Cattle, Beef, Sheep, Horse and 4-H Classes are requested to meet and report themselves to the Secretary's Office not later than 1 hour before show time on the day of the respective show and will be furnished with Badges, Class Books and Prize Tickets, so as to enable them to proceed with the judging of their respective classes immediately.

The Judges will, in the execution of their duties, be careful to act with the most rigid impartiality; will make their entries in a clear and conspicuous manner; in all cases of doubt or difficulty referring to the Committee of Directors in charge of the Department; and when they have completed their reports, will sign and deliver their books to the Secretary.

Upon the discovery of any fraud, deception or dishonest practice, either in preparation, ownership or misrepresentation concerning any article exhibited, which may have been intended to affect the decision of the judges, the Board of Directors will have the power to withhold the payment of any prize awarded. All participants must be members of the Society.
